



PETS Travel Scheme Requirements

In order for dogs, cats and ferrets to enter the UK from, or re-enter the UK after having travelled to a PETS Scheme EU Member or approved non EU Countries, the following criteria need to be met:

- A microchip needs to be inserted prior to the Rabies vaccination
Microchip £15.00
- The animal must be vaccinated against Rabies (minimum age 12 weeks)
Rabies vaccination £72.35
- A few days after, your vet will issue a PETS passport which you can collect from the practice.
Passport £45
- **Dogs** – When you are returning to the UK your dog must be treated for tapeworm 1-5 days before arriving in the UK. This must be administered by a vet in the country you are staying in and reported within the relevant section in the passport.

IMPORTANT

Animals complying with these criteria can only travel once a period of 21 days has lapsed since the date of the Rabies vaccination or annual booster/catch up vaccines.
