Exotic Animal Service

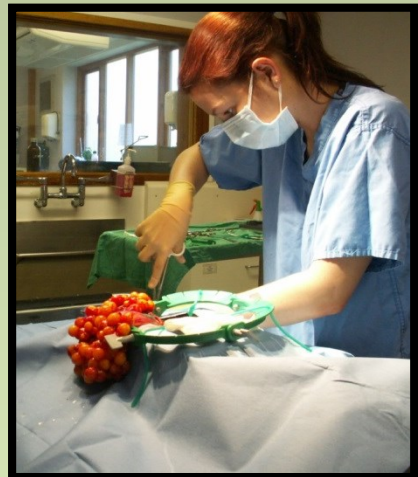
The Scott Veterinary Clinic offers an excellent Exotic Animal Service to clients, referring vets and zoological collections.

We treat a wide range of species including mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians.

Our Exotic Animal Service is led by our Head of Exotics Nathalie Wissink-Argilaga. Nathalie has many years experience in this specialised field of veterinary medicine.

Our service offers:

- General health checks and post purchase examinations
- A full medical and surgical service for all exotic species
- Husbandry and nutritional advice for exotic pets
- In-house Laboratory
- Disease screening service: PBFD, Chlamydia, E. cuniculi
- Dentistry for mammals (Rabbits, Rodents)
- Specialised diagnostics, monitoring and surgical equipment
- Digital X-ray, ultrasound, endoscopy
- Advice and x-ray interpretation service for referring vets



Facilities

We provide on-site digital radiography, ultrasound and both rigid and flexible endoscopy.



Our surgical facilities support the needs of our exotic patients. Our in-house laboratory provides rapid same day results.

We have the facilities and expertise to perform soft tissue and orthopaedic procedures in many species.

All anaesthetic and surgical protocols are tailored to the species and the individual patient.

A specialised exotics ward includes individual thermostatically controlled isolation avian units with facilities for oxygen delivery, temperature control, nebulisation and controlled ventilation. Fully equipped vivaria for Reptiles.

A separate small mammal ward with controlled lighting and temperature.

Our highly qualified nursing staff, including Exotic Species Nursing Certificate holders, provide an excellent standard of patient care to ensure maximum comfort and security.
